**Purpose:** Connecting with Nature's Ways, teachings, and transforming with Sacred Law

**Forum:** Talking Stick Circles (Morning and Night), traveling the Four Corners, Mesa Verde, Chaco Canyon, and potential River Rafting, Tubing

**Location:** Open camping near Eagles Home 9162 CR 141 Hesperus, Colorado USA. There is outdoor camping, fire pit, and is located southwest of Durango, about 10 miles. Hosts will provide kitchen supplies and food staples for moderate diets. **Note!** Gear may be shipped in before arrival. Please contact for details.
